Leduc & District Food Bank Association: Council reviewed and agreed to consider contributing \$500 to the food bank at the time 2018 budgets are in discussion.

Arena Upgrade: Leduc County has agreed to approve a recommendation in support of the draft concept redevelopment plan to the Warburg Arena and authorized a Provincial Lottery application of upto \$1 million to support Phase 1.

The Village is looking great as numerous unsightly areas have been addressed and will continue to be followed up on.
