Snow Removal-Bylaw Reminder

With winter on its way, we would like to remind residents of the following: Section 3 of Bylaw No. 27-98 states that for the removal of snow and ice from sidewalks in the Village of Warburgis as follows:

Every occupant, and in case there is no occupant, then the owner of every house, shop, building, lot or parcel of land and every person having charge of care of any public building shall, within the first twenty four (24) hours after every fall of snow cause the same to be removed off the sidewalks from or abutting each house, shop, building, lot or parcel of land respectively and shall also keep the said sidewalk free of all ice which may be deposited there on.

The Village of Warburg may be required to contract out the cleaning of your sidewalks that have not been attended to within a period of 24 hours following a snowfall. You will be invoiced for all costs incurred.

Christmas Hours

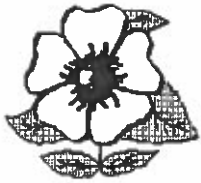

Village Drinking Water

The Village drinking water comes from three wells. The raw water from the wells flows to and enters into the raw water storage tank at the Water Treatment Plant and then goes through the Nano filtration system. From the Water Treatment Plant the filtered water then goes into the water reservoir, at which time the chlorine is added and the potable water is distributed to the residents and businesses connected to the Municipal water system. The chlorine is the only chemical that is added to the water, and must be added as per Alberta Environment's regulations. In order to keep the chlorine level up, as per the Code of Practice for Waterworks Systems, at all the dead ends and lines located farthest away from the reservoir, the reservoir levels must be higher at the reservoir, therefore the closer you are to the reservoir the more chlorine will be in your water. The level for the chlorine residual is tested daily from the reservoir and from one random location from various residents within the distribution system. In addition, a weekly water sample is taken from random various locations within the distribution system and forwarded to the Alberta Government Lab for testing.
