To ensure no underground interference. Once the Locates are done by first call all underground utilities will be daylighted via hydrovac



Hand Holes will need to be placed to accommodate the splice enclosures throughout the network.

The collective subdivisions around pigeon lake have overhead power. There is new electrical code that will unfortunately make going on the existing poles legally impossible. We will be placing the fiber using directional boring. This also has the added security benefit of not being susceptible to trees blowing down across the wires and needing constant repair. Once its in the ground it will be safer



There will also be pedestals used as needed to place the fiber. These are much more convenient for the deployment of the passive optical network and will be placed out of the way as much as possible.



There will be “flower pots” left at every second property line along both sides of the road. This is where the conduit for the fttb will be located to provide the drop, when required, to each residence

The successful placement of the fttb in the most unobtrusive way is to directionally bore along the roads and in some cases from the roads to the residences.

The drop to the homes and cabins is on a voluntary basis. Only those who wish to have service will pay any fees. The conduit will be either bored or plowed in
