

## Village of Warburg

Public meeting of the Village of Warburg held Monday, April 27, 2015 in  
The Village of Warburg Basement Conference Room.

### Call to Order

Mayor van Assen called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. with

Mayor van Assen opened up the meeting requesting for discussions from the  
public.

Ms. Spasoff addressed concerns on behalf of Carol from Warburg Agencies in  
regards to the water pooling on the sidewalk by the door of their business,  
recycled tire on their boulevard and street sweeping.

Ms. Spasoff addressed her concern in regards to the water pooling in front of the  
east side of her property and on the road paving within the Village.

The 2016 sidewalk project RFP will include the sidewalk in front of Warburg  
Agencies, the street sweeping is currently being arranged for the week of May  
11<sup>th</sup> and the boulevard concern was addressed which may be included in this  
year's project or in the next go round. Public works has been dealing with the  
water pooling concern in front of Ms. Spasoffs residence and will be directed to  
look into this further.

Mr. Begg addressed his concerns in regards to the traffic driving fast past his  
place causing a lot of dust, the abundance of trailers using his road to go to the  
RV Park/dump station – could this be due to signage. Mr. Begg also had a  
concern in regards to snow removal from sidewalks and the cost.

The speeding of vehicles is a RCMP matter and the Village will look into getting  
or making the RV Park signs more visible.

Mr. Halabi addressed his concerns in regards to the snow removal and mowing  
costs on his two lots that he purchased 5 years ago to construct a store. Felt  
that being they are attached he should be charged for only one lot.

Councillor Maine explained the purpose of the bylaws and the reasoning they  
were established. Deputy Mayor Rapati noted that when Mr. Halabi is going to  
build they may make the lots into one lot if required to do so, but at this time they  
are 2 separate lots.

There were no further questions or concerns.
