The Town of Millet received 5 Blooms - Bronze and a special mention for Millet in Bloom 20th Anniversary Project during the National Symposium and Awards Ceremonies in Kamloops, BC. The Town of Millet participated in the Class of Champions (Small) category along with Antigonish NS, Ashcroft BC, Pincher Creek AB, Sussex NB, and Tignish PE. Over the summer, trained volunteer judges evaluated the overall contributions of municipal council and departments; industry; businesses and the private sector – including volunteer efforts – in regards to the following criteria: Tidiness, Environmental Action, Heritage Conservation, Urban Forestry, Landscape and Floral Displays. Following their evaluation, volunteer judges Lorraine Hunter and Gerry Teahen wrote: “A 30 foot diameter wagon wheel, the rim and spokes cemented with a 3 foot base in the centre to hold an engraved rock that reads “Millet Communities in Bloom 20th Anniversary 1996 – 2015.” The soil between the spokes holds groundcover perennials. Contributors to the project have their names on a plaque in front of the wagon wheel. The design, framing, concrete work, soil leveling and planting were done by volunteers. Soil/dirt removal and delivery of new soil was done by Public Works. The cost of the project including in-kind support was just over \$10,000”. Within the actual context of climate changes and environmental concerns, communities involved in the program can be proud of their efforts, which provide real and meaningful environmental solutions and benefit all of society.
