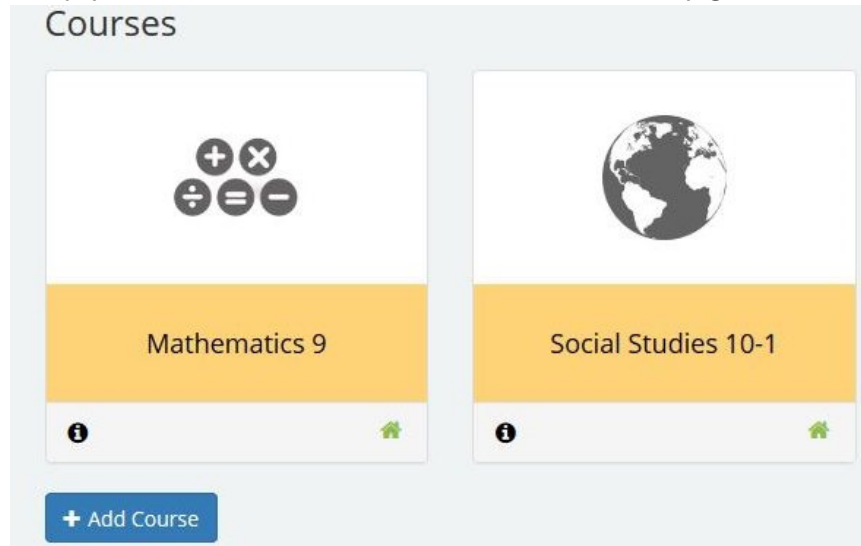


## Using Solaro

Simply click on the course icon to enter the study guide

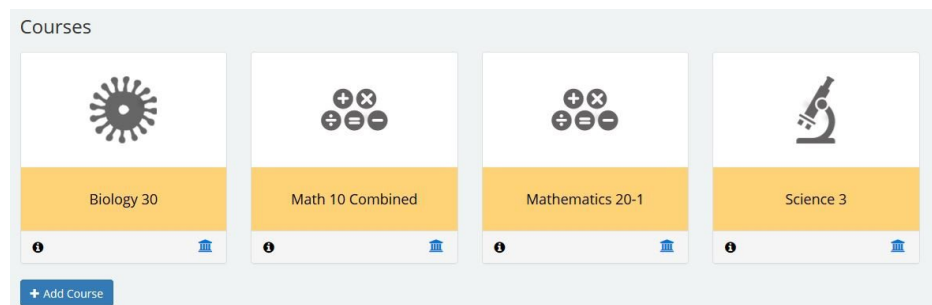


Click on the unit of interest, and then the lessons.

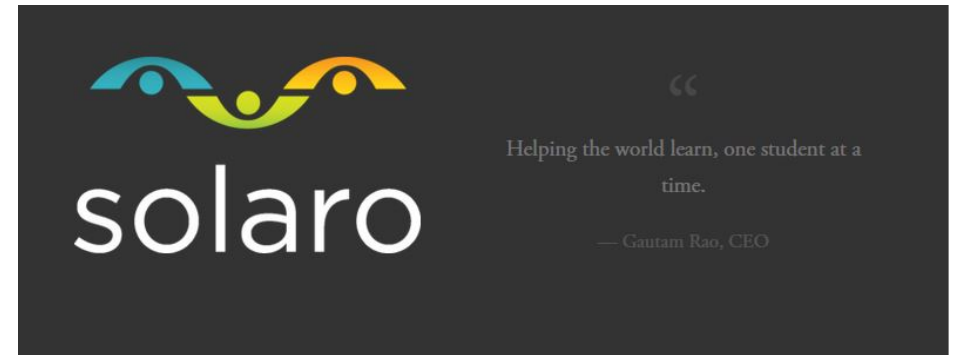
There are pre and post tests, and practice tests for each unit.

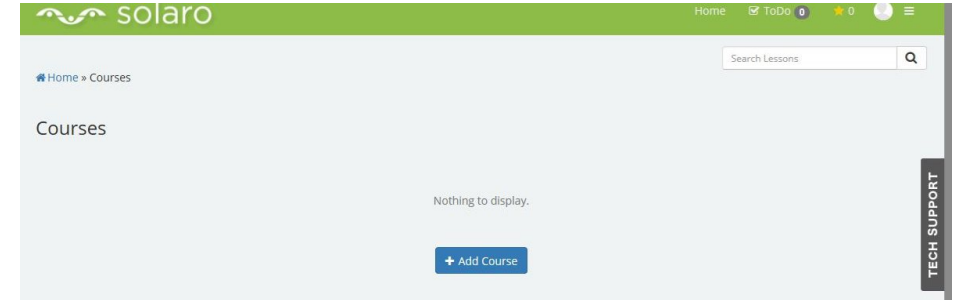

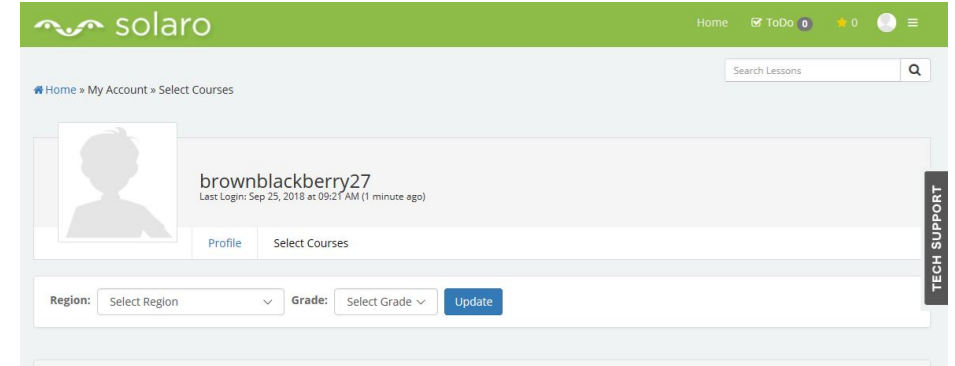

# Using Solaro

Once logged into Solaro, a prompt to add courses appears.



Click 'Add Course' to bring up a list of Provinces and grade levels.



Once the Region and Grade are updated, a list of courses will appear. One grade above and one grade below will show up, in addition to the chosen grade level.
