Snowplow Flags for Senior Citizens or Disabled Persons – The County is changing the flags for senior citizens and disabled persons who currently have their driveways plowed. All Senior Citizens and Disabled persons should have received a letter in the mail requesting that they return their yellow flag in exchange for a green flag. Alberta Community Partnership (ACP) Grants – In anticipation of the Alberta Community Partnership Grant program being announced shortly for the 2018-2019 intake, County Council passed motions to:

- partner with the Summer Village of Horseshoe Bay and the Town of Elk Point to complete and implement two Stormwater Management Plans;
- partner with the Town of Elk Point and Town of St. Paul for a Regional Human Resources Services Needs Analysis and Framework Development;
- partner with our Urban Neighbours – the Towns of St. Paul and Elk Point and the Summer Village of Horseshoe Bay for funding for a Regional Economic Development Strategic Plan.
