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Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to establish guidelines under which premises within the Town of Millet that are currently serviced by private water wells are to connect to the Town Water supply.

Definitions

- a) “Development Authority” means the designated officer who has the authority to exercise development powers on behalf of the Town.
- b) “Owner” means the registered owner of a residence, as per the Alberta Land Titles Act.
- c) “Premises” includes lands and buildings.
- d) “Town” means the Municipal Corporation of the Town of Millet
- e) “Water Service Line” means the water line from the distributing street mains to the property line of the lands or building being serviced.

Guidelines

- a) All applications for Utility Service Connections must be made to the development authority by the Owner.
- b) If the premises have not paid a Local Improvement Levy for the construction of the water main, the premise will be charged a connection fee of \$1378.00 per connection of a water service line.
- c) Construction of utility service connection must be made in accordance with Town of Millet Bylaw 2012/12 being the Town of Millet Water and Sewer Regulations Bylaw, and with Town of Millet Policy #51 being the “minimum design standards.”

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
