

TOWN OF VERMILION

---BY-LAW 14-77---

A By-Law to provide for the establishment of a public library in the Town of Vermilion pursuant to Part 3 of The Libraries Act, 1970 and amendments thereto.

WHEREAS a petition signed by at least one tenth of the resident electors of the Town of Vermilion was received by the Council of the said Town, to pass a By-Law to establish a public library,

AND WHEREAS more than 50 percent of the persons voting voted in favour of a By-Law to establish a public library in a vote of electors taken on the 2nd day of March, 1953.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Vermilion duly assembled hereby enacts as follows:

1. There shall be established a municipal library in the Town of Vermilion to be known as "That Vermilion Public Library".
2. The general management, regulation and control of the Vermilion Public Library is vested in and shall be exercised by a board of management known as "The Vermilion Library Board."
3. The appointment of members, the terms of office, the time of appointments and the duties and responsibilities of the Vermilion Library Board shall be in accordance with the provisions of The Libraries Act 1970 and amendments thereto.
4. (1) Annual appointments of the members of the Vermilion Library Board, shall be made at
 - (a) the first meeting of Council following the date for Municipal elections in any year in which a general election is required to be held or,
 - (b) the annual organizational meeting of Council in any year in which a general election is not required to be held,

and in the case of any vacancy arising from any cause shall be filled at the first meeting of Council after the vacancy occurs.

(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1) where appointments are first made under this By-Law, Council shall as nearly as may be possible, appoint one third of the members for a term of one year, one third of the members for a term of two years and the remaining members for a term of three years and the first

appointments shall be effective at the first meeting of Council in January, 1978.


5. By-Law Numbers 6-53 and 5-74 are hereby repealed.

6. This By-Law comes into effect on the 1st day of January, 1978.
