PLEASE READ THIS SECTION BEFORE COMPLETING THE APPLICATION:

- Puppies do not require a license until 6 months of age, provided they are the offspring of a dog licensed in Thorsby.*
- No person shall keep or have more than two (2), in any combination thereof, of dogs, nuisance dogs or restricted dogs on any premises with a municipal address in the Town. If you have recently moved to the community and have more than the permitted number of dogs, please ask about a special permit.*
- At least one person named on the license must be 18 years of age or older.*
- The dog must wear a collar/harness with the issued dog tag attached, when off the owner/licensee's property.*

Definitions:

“Dog” means any domesticated dog:

“Dog tag” means the unique numbered identification tag issued to the licensee for attachment to the licensed dog collar or harness for the intention of future identification:

“Nuisance dog” means any dog that has been the subject of three or more offences within the previous three years for any combination of the following offences under this bylaw:

- a) Excessive Barking*
- b) Defecation*
- c) Off property of the owner (running at large)*

“Restricted dog” means any dog:

- a. That has chased, attacked or bitten any person or animal causing physical injury and resulting in an offence under this bylaw’*
- b. That has chased, attacked or bitten any person or animal on more than one occasion, with or without causing physical injury, and resulting in separate offences under this bylaw; or*
- c. That has been made the subject of an order under the Dangerous Dogs Act;*

“License” means a license issued pursuant to this bylaw;

“Licensee” means a person named on a License.

“Owner” includes any person:

Named on a License; or

In actual or apparent possession or control of property where a dog apparently resides.

“Puppy” means a dog under the age of six months
