



## Master Checklist

**Camp Sunshine** is located at the Reunion Station (White building in the soccer field, north of the Co-op Mall). It runs from 9:00 am until 3:00pm on Tues., Wed, Thurs., & Fri., July 09–12, 2019.

A morning snack, nutritious lunch, and afternoon snack will be provided.

- Drop off your camper at **8:45 am** every morning, as we need to start promptly at 9:00 a.m. We have a full agenda of fun activities, guest artists, musicians, chefs and of course, lots of “grief work” to do.
- Pick up your camper at **3:15 pm** every afternoon (except for Friday).
- Have your child bring a **4"x 6" photo** of his/her loved one who died - this will be part of the sharing circle on the first day of Camp and used in one of the craft projects.
- Clothing:** Camp Sunshine is an active and comfortable place. With this in mind, have your camper wear comfy things: loose-fitting t-shirts; shorts or pants; and running shoes. Also bring a sun hat, sunglasses, jacket in case of rain, and hoodie or sweater. Please label these items with the child’s name so we can return them if they are left behind.
- The Camp will provide sun screen, unless your child has allergies or you want to provide your own. If so, please label the bottle with your camper’s name.
- Our sharing circles will be done while sitting on floor mats, so have your camper bring a cushion or pillow - label it as well.
- If your child requires medication during Camp hours, remember to give us the Dr.’s name and phone number, bring the medication in it’s original packaging, and a schedule of times and doses required. This will be supervised by the Camp Director.
- A closing Remembrance Ceremony will take place on Friday, July 13 at 3:00 pm, followed by a family BBQ. Please mark this date on your calendar and join in the celebration.

### Items Not Allowed at Camp

**Please do not bring to camp** cell phones, cameras, ipads, ipods, video games, or any other electronic equipment. Tobacco products, weapons, and fireworks are not permitted. Do not bring any food, money, jewellery, or pets. Thank your for your cooperation in this.
