**New for 2019 – TWO forms** are now required to be completed by candidates running for office:  
Form 4 – Nomination Paper and Candidate's Acceptance – 2 page form  
Form 5 – Candidate Information – 1 page form

### Boat Equipment Storage Agreement

Please read the following excerpt from Norris Beach Bylaw #159, Municipal Properties Bylaw:

a) Owners of property in the Summer Village of Norris Beach may store boat lifts, docks, and associated equipment on Municipal Property subject to the following conditions:

- i. Residents require a one time permit to store all marked items from the Summer Villages Office at no cost.
- ii. All lifts and dock sections must be clearly marked with the owner's Norris lot number for identification.
- iii. Any unmarked or unverifiable equipment may be deemed to be abandoned and subsequently removed at the owner's expense.
- iv. All stored material must be removed by June 1 and not returned to storage until September 1 of each year unless special permission is granted by Council and only prior to June 1<sup>st</sup>.

Attached for your convenience is the form to store your boat equipment on Municipal property. Please note that pier stands must be clearly marked with your lot number as well.

As per Bylaw # 159, a permit is required for the storage of boat lifts and docks on municipal property. I, the undersigned, request permission to store the following item(s) on Municipal Property in the Summer Village of Norris Beach.

Conditions:

1. Boat lifts, docks, Pier stands and associated equipment may be stored in designated areas only. Boat and trailer storage is prohibited on municipal property at any time.
2. Storage must be done on grassed areas in such a manner as public access to the lake is not blocked or impaired. The Summer Village may designate certain areas.
3. Vegetation including brush or trees must not be damaged to clear areas for such storage.
4. All stored equipment must be clearly marked with the owner lot number for identification and registered, with the owners contact information, at the Village Office. **Any unmarked or unverifiable equipment will be deemed abandoned and removed.**
5. Storage is permitted during the off-season only. All stored material must be removed from June 1<sup>st</sup> to September 1<sup>st</sup> of each year.
6. Owners of equipment stored in Municipal Property shall be responsible for safely locating the equipment and maintaining it in good condition without risk to the public or the environment. The Summer Village of Norris Beach assumes no liability for this equipment or its use by the Owner or the Public. The Owners of such equipment shall be liable for any and all damages caused by the storage of such property.
7. Storage privileges are subject to availability of space. This agreement can be rescinded at any time by the Summer Village of Norris Beach in its sole discretion.
8. Dock sections must be stacked, preferably on boat lifts, to minimize occupied space. Connected dock sections are prohibited.

I agree to the conditions listed above and acknowledge that, under the terms of the Municipal Properties Bylaw, failure to comply with these conditions can result in a fine and removal of property.
