Road Construction – July 2019

Please be advised that ANT Construction from Red Deer has scheduled the road construction project in the Summer Village of Grandview scheduled to begin the week of July 8-12, 2019. This scheduled start is dependent on weather. The road construction project is expected to take 4-5 weeks (again depending on weather).

Any rain that falls will delay the project as dry weather is essential for the cement stabilization.

All residents asked to not park any vehicles on the road when the work is being completed in your area.

The contractor will be working in 250-meter sections and these areas of the roads will be closed for approximately a day. Please ensure your vehicles are parked away from this area to ensure you will have access to come and go.

The Road Construction Project will be completed in various stages/sections.

Section 1:

Is Township Road 464 (Mail Boxes) to the westside of the Summer Village.

- *This section will be ground, cement stabilization added and then chip sealed.*

Section 2:

Is Lakeshore Drive from Township Road 464 (Mail Boxes) to the municipal boundary at the north end of the summer village entering into Poplar Bay.

- *This section will be ground, cement stabilization, and then chip sealed.*

Sections 3:

Is from the south entrance of the Summer Village to Township Road 464 (Mail Boxes).

- *This section will have spray filling and cold mix patches and then chip sealed.*

Section 4:

Is Buskmose Drive

- This section will have spray filling and cold mix patches and then chip sealed.

The project is scheduled to begin with Section 1 (Township Road 464) and then proceed to the other sections. Chip sealing will be done as the final stage of this project

If you have questions regarding parking in your area during construction in your area, you may get directions from the Flag Person.
