Assessment Review Board (ARB)

- The board is called upon only when a ratepayer files an assessment complaint that has not been resolved by the assessor.
- Training is provided and mandatory for all board members to sit at a hearing. All members are trained for the Local Assessment Review Board (LARB) and Composite Assessment Review Board (CARB) at a 4-day course by Municipal Affairs and a 2-day refresher course every 3 years after that to maintain their ARB certification.

In a written submission, please describe your skills/knowledge you would bring to the board, and how the Town of St. Paul would benefit from your participation. Members will be eligible for paid training, meeting honoraria and travel expenses. The deadline to apply is **November 19, 2019 (12Noon)**.
