- Alberta Fisheries looking for remediation efforts to reduce potential impact to fish stocks
- Back lane deterioration spots – black dirt coming through
- Impacts to planned gravelling program vs reactive response


Discussion occurred regarding the various issues and prioritization of actions

- Lidar aerial of Thorsby to enable planning and action for water diversion to protect both current and future infrastructure development/maintenance
- Cleaning of river intake to protect water source/infrastructure
- Define and action a plan acceptable to Alberta Fisheries to avoid fines
- Cleaning of lift station to maintain maximization of flow through
