### Covid 19 Update for the Summer Village of Grandview – June 22, 2020

The Summer Village of Grandview is following the provincial guidelines during this time of the Covid-19 pandemic. Recently restrictions were lifted for outdoor gatherings to allow groups of up to 100 to be held and to allow playgrounds to open. As such, we are announcing the following changes within our summer village:

1. **Playground:** The playground at Hamblin Park has been re-opened. Signs have been posted to remind users of the precautions to be taken when using the playground. The Summer Village does not maintain a program for sanitizing the playground equipment.
2. **Annual Information Meeting:** The AIM will be held at Hamblin Park on July 18<sup>th</sup> at 10 am. There will not be a Zoom meeting as previously announced. The usual number of attendees is less than 100 but if required, a second session will be held later in the day. All required social distancing guidelines will be followed and those attending should consider wearing facemasks. Unfortunately, the BBQ will not be held.
3. **Monthly Meet and Greet meetings:** Your Council will reinstitute the Meet and Greet meetings at the Gazebo on long weekends. These informal gatherings are to provide updates of issues pertinent to the residents of Grandview. Social distancing guidelines will be followed and facemasks are recommended. 4. **July 1<sup>st</sup> Celebrations:** We will not be holding the Penny Carnival, Music Night in the Park nor the July 1st BBQ this year.
