The Equipment Operator is responsible for operating and maintaining equipment and ensuring the Town's roads, alleys, and landscaped areas are in good repair and are safe for public use.

Responsibilities

- Street sweeping
- Mowing grass
- Alley grading
- Pothole repair/street repairs
- Hauling of material
- Excavating of water, sewer lines for repair or replacement
- Sign maintenance and replacement
- Picking up leaves in fall/spring
- Keeping equipment clean and in good working order
- Sanding and plowing of roads/clearing of snow on Town sidewalks/parking lots
- Assisting in all other functions as required (water & sewer)
- Minor repairs and servicing to equipment

- Work with little or no supervision
