The Town of St. Paul is seeking members-at-large to fill a number of vacancies on the following boards and/or committees.

1 Position - Family and Community Support Services (FCSS) Advisory Board

- The FCSS promotes and encourages citizen awareness and participation in programming and intervention programs.
- This board meets monthly.
- Term: 2 years

1 Position - Subdivision and Development Appeal Board (SDAB)

- The SDAB is a quasi-judicial board that hears and makes decisions on appeals related to stop orders, developments and subdivisions. Functions in accordance with the Municipal Government Act and the Town of St. Paul SDAB Bylaw.
- This board meets as required when an appeal is filed to the Secretary of the SDAB.
- Training is provided and mandatory for all board members.
- Term: 1 year

1 Position – Waste & Recycling Committee (Citizens Advisory)

- The mandate of the Committee assists in planning and implementing a modernized community waste and recycling program and is advisory to the Town Council on matters relating to municipal solid waste (MSW).
- The board usually meets every second month.
- Term: 2 years
