# **Current Status**

Council and Administration reviewed a spreadsheet detailing the current status of resident compliance to the new wastewater bylaw. Communication will be relayed to residents indicating that 80% of sewage fields have been rejected to date as well as a summary of project status so far. A Norris Beach resident expressed his concerns regarding the wastewater project via email to Council; the email was discussed and a response will be drafted and sent to the resident in response to his concerns.

Council determined that it would be appropriate to waive development permit fees for the decommissioning and/or installation of private sewage disposal systems in accordance with the wastewater bylaw.

# Res. #11-19

Moved by Deputy Mayor Fowlie that the development permit fees for decommissioning/installation of private sewage disposal systems for Norris Beach residents be waived, to assist them in becoming compliant to Norris Beach Wastewater Bylaw #123 and amending Bylaw #124.
