

WASTE MANAGEMENT POLICY #4304

17. The Summer Village of Ma-Me-O Beach, with a capital and operating agreement, will be issued cards through the Summer Village office and will be subject to all fees contained in the policy, invoiced directly to the Summer Village office monthly.

The following disposal fees are required to be charged:

General Waste:	
Less than 1 Ton	No Charge
1 Ton ¹	\$50
Appliances (white goods) with or without Freon:	
Refrigerators, freezers, stoves, washers, dryers, dishwashers, air conditioners, water coolers	\$20
Propane Cylinders:	
5 Pounds or Less	No Charge
6 to 100 Pounds	\$20
More than 100 Pounds	Not Accepted
Tires	No Charge
Wire ² (Spooled with Posts Removed only)	No Charge
Scrap Metal	No Charge
Recycling	
Each transfer station may accept different commodities such as newsprint, mixed paper, paint, chemical containers, used oil & filters, e-waste.	No Charge
Town of Millet ³	\$20 per any portion up to a ½ ton ⁴

¹ The definition of a 1 Ton load is a vehicle that contains more than a two foot depth of waste (non household, non bagged). There will be no charges for a 1 Ton load that is bagged. Nothing larger than a 1 ton truck equivalent will be accepted.

² If wire is not rolled with posts removed material will be rejected.

³ Nothing larger than a ½ ton truck equivalent will be accepted in accordance with the Transfer Station Agreement between the County and the Town of Millet.

⁴ A half ton load is defined as a half ton truck with no side extensions.
