Contact your local library personnel for assistance with mobile devices and Library PressDisplay.

- 1 Search by keyword or specific text in current and previous issues.
- 2 Search by date or go to advanced search.
- 3 Select a specific Newspaper.
- 4 Choose which language to view the screen in.
- 5 Access help and support screens.
- 6 Scroll through the list of newspapers and journals
- 7 Scroll through the top news stories.
- 8 Access a flash demonstration.
- 9 Display top news from any day in the past week.
- 10 View the most recent headlines.
- 11 View the world in pictures slideshow.
